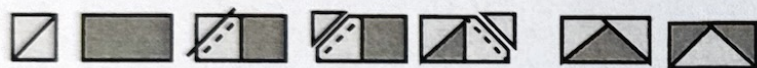


CUTIE collections



Repeat on the opposite end of the cutie 3 piece noting direction of the drawn line to make a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" Flying Geese unit. Repeat to make a total of 4 units.

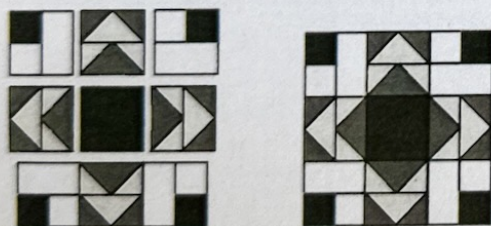
In the same manner, make a total of 4 contrary Flying Geese units using the other cutie 2 and 3 pieces.



3. Side units. Sew each Flying Geese unit and a contrary Flying Geese unit together as shown to make a total of (4) 5" side units.



4. Sew the 4 corner units, 4 side units, and the 5" cutie 1 square together into 3 rows of 3 units each. Press row seams in opposing directions, then sew the rows together to complete one 14" x 14" block.



QUILT ASSEMBLY:

1. Noting placement, sew the panel blocks and pieced blocks alternately together into 3 rows of 3 blocks each. Press row seams in opposing directions, then sew the rows together to complete the 41" x 41" quilt center.

2. Inner border. Trim (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips to measure 41" long and sew to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the border. Sew 3 inner border strips short ends (or diagonally) together to make one long strip. Cut (2) 45" lengths. Sew these strips to the other sides of the quilt center.

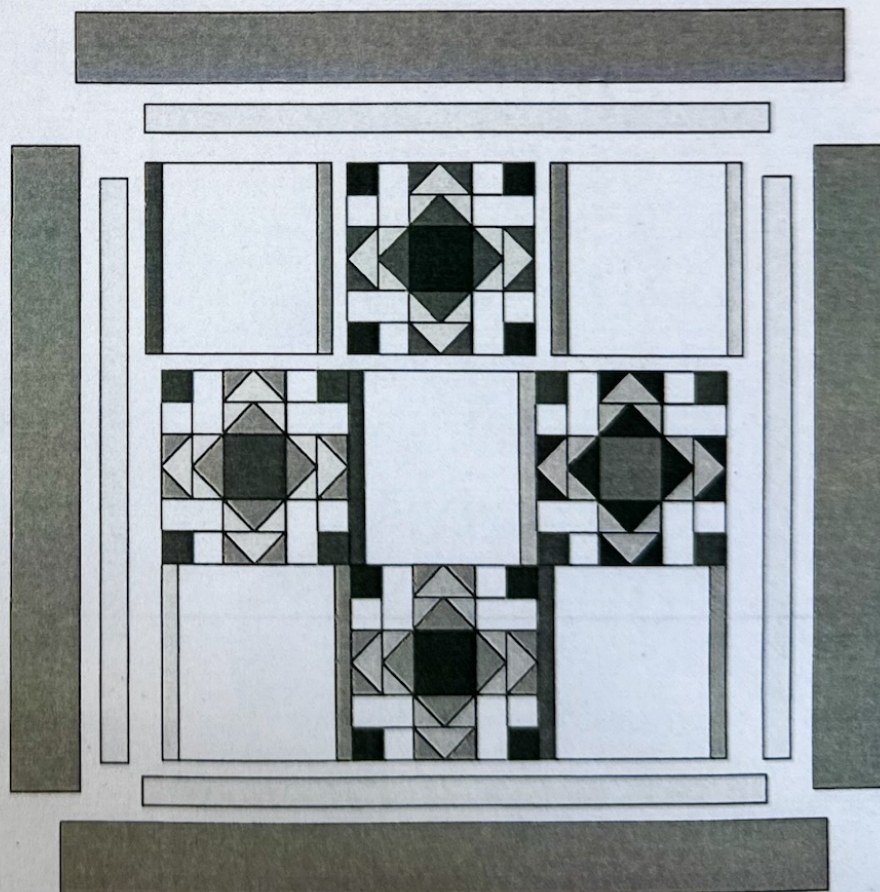

3. Outer border. Sew the (5) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide outer border strips short ends together to make one long strip. Cut (2) 45" lengths and (2) 55" lengths. Sew the shorter strips to opposite sides of the quilt top and the longer strips to the other sides. Press seams toward the outer border.

4. Finishing. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF binding strips (see the *Cutie Glossary* for binding instructions).

Q-TEE

Quilt size: 55" x 55" Finished Block size: 13½" x 13½"

MATERIALS:

Cutie pack	1
Panel (or focus) print	1 panel (or 1 yard)
Background	½ yard
Inner border	½ yard
Outer border & binding	1½ yards
Batting	63" x 63" piece
Backing	63" x 63" piece

CUTTING:

Notes: Each of the 4 pieced blocks contain 3 different cuties. Mix and match 12 cuties into 4 sets of 3 cuties each (1 set/pieced block). Label the cuties in each set as: cutie 1, cutie 2, and cutie 3. Keep the pieces in separate piles by set after cutting. Width of fabric (WOF) is fabric cut from selvage to selvage.

From cutie 1 in each set, cut:

- (1) 5" x 22" strip;
subcut (1) 5" square and (4) 2¾" squares
(for pieced blocks)
- (1) 1½" x 14" strip (for panel blocks)

From each of cutie 2 and 3 in each set, cut:

- (4) 2¾" x 5" pieces (for Flying Geese units)
- (8) 2¾" squares (for Flying Geese units)

From the remaining cuties, cut a total of:

- (6) 1½" x 14" strips (for panel blocks)

From the panel print (for focus print), fussy cut:

- (5) 12" x 14" pieces centered on the desired motif

From the background, cut:

- (4) 2¾" x WOF strips;
subcut (16) 2¾" x 5" pieces and (16) 2¾" squares
(for pieced blocks)

From the inner border fabric, cut:

- (5) 2½" x WOF strips

From the outer border & binding fabric, cut:

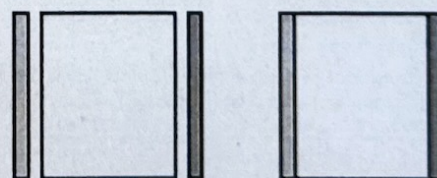
- (5) 5½" x WOF strips (for border)
- (6) 2½" x WOF strips (for binding)

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Note: Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even. Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout.

Panel (or focus print) Blocks

1. Sew a different 1½" x 14" cutie strip to the long sides of each 12" x 14" panel (or focus fabric) piece. Press seams toward the cutie strips to make (5) 14" x 14" panel blocks.



Pieced Blocks.

1. **Corner units.** From one set of cuties: Sew a 2¾" cutie 1 square to a 2¾" background square. Press seams toward the cutie. Sew this unit to a 2¾" x 5" background piece to make one 5" square. Make a total of 4 units.



2. **Flying Geese units.** From the same set of cuties: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 2¾" cutie 2 squares. Place a marked square right sides together on one end of the 2¾" x 5" cutie 3 piece. Sew on the drawn line, trim ¼" away from the line through both layers, then press the triangle open.
