



BLOCK ASSEMBLY, CONT:

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make (4) $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ medium pinwheel blocks using the $4\frac{7}{8}"$ light and dark cuties. Mix and match the light and dark squares for a variety of different cutie pinwheel blocks, making sure to pair 2 sets of identical squares together to yield 4 identical hst (needed for each pinwheel).
4. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make (24) $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ small pinwheel blocks using the $2\frac{7}{8}"$ light and dark cuties. Mix and match the light and dark squares for a variety of different cutie pinwheel blocks, making sure to pair 2 sets of identical squares together to yield 4 identical hst (needed for each pinwheel).

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Quilt center. Sew an $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ background piece between two medium pinwheel blocks to make the top row. Press seams toward the background fabric. Repeat to make a second, bottom row.

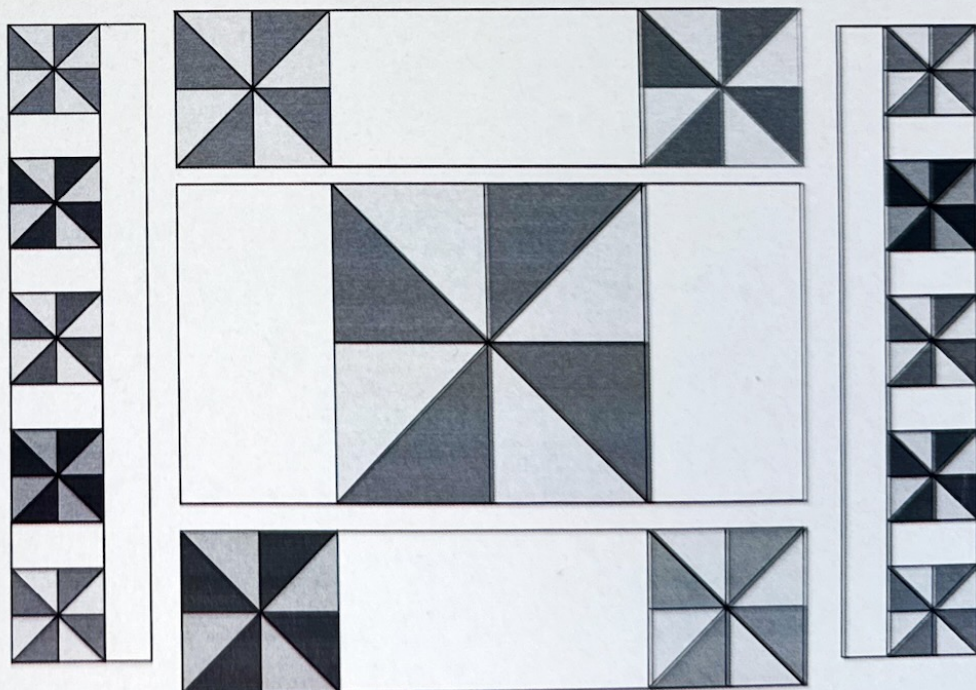
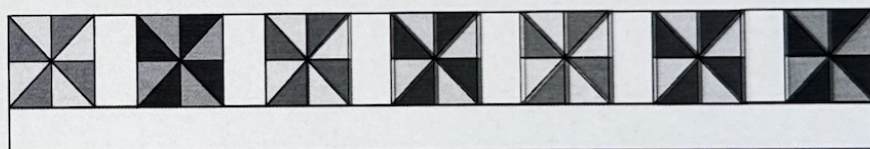
Sew the large pinwheel block between two $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ background pieces to make the center row. Press seams toward the background fabric.

Sew the center row between the top and bottom row to complete the $28\frac{1}{2}" \times 28\frac{1}{2}"$ quilt center.

Side borders. Sew 5 small pinwheel blocks alternately together with (4) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ background pieces to make one $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 28\frac{1}{2}"$ strip. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 28\frac{1}{2}"$ background strip to one long side of the pinwheel strip. Press seams toward the background fabric.

Repeat to make a second strip. Noting placement, sew these strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the background fabric.

Top and bottom borders. Sew 7 small pinwheel blocks alternately together with (6) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ background pieces to make one $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 40\frac{1}{2}"$ strip. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 40\frac{1}{2}"$ background strip to one long side. Press seams toward the background fabric. Make a second strip. Noting placement, sew a strip to the top and another to the bottom of the quilt center.



Finishing. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times$ WOF binding strips (see *Cutie Glossary* for binding instructions).

CUTIE

collections
(16 Fat Eighths)



MATERIALS:

Cutie Pack	1
Background, border, & binding	1 ³ / ₈ yards
Batting	48" x 48" piece
Backing	48" x 48" piece

CUTTING:

Note: Separate the cuties into 2 piles (8 cuties each) of light and dark values. Width of fabric (WOF) is fabric cut from selvage to selvage.

From each of 1 light cutie and 1 dark cutie:

- Cut (2) 6⁷/₈" squares (for large pinwheel)
- Cut (4) 2⁷/₈" squares (for small pinwheels)

From each of 4 light cuties and 4 dark cuties:

- Cut (2) 4⁷/₈" squares (for medium pinwheels)
- Cut (4) 2⁷/₈" squares (for small pinwheels)

From each of 3 light cuties and 3 dark cuties:

- Cut (10) 2⁷/₈" squares (for small pinwheels)

From the background, border, & binding:

- Cut (1) 12¹/₂" x WOF strip;
subcut (4) 8¹/₂" x 12¹/₂" pieces
- Cut (2) 2¹/₂" x 28¹/₂" strips
- Cut (2) 2¹/₂" x 40¹/₂" strips
- Cut (3) 2¹/₂" x WOF strips;
subcut (20) 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" pieces
- Cut (5) 2¹/₂" x WOF strips (for binding)

BOBO

Quilt size: 40" x 40"

Block size: 12" x 12", 8" x 8", 4" x 4",

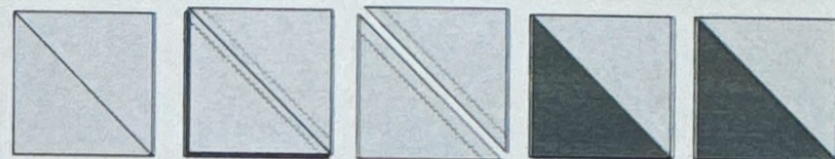

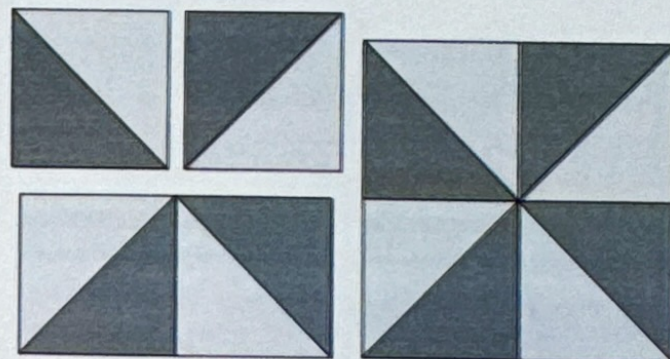
BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Note: Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even. Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 6⁷/₈" light cutie square. Place the square right sides together with a 6⁷/₈" dark cutie square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn line, cut apart on the line, then open and press the seam toward the dark cutie to yield 2 half-square triangle units (hst). Repeat to make a second set of hst using the other 6⁷/₈" light and dark cutie squares.



2. Noting orientation, sew the hst together in pairs, press seams in opposing directions, then sew the pairs together to complete 1 large pinwheel block. Trim to measure 12¹/₂" x 12¹/₂".
