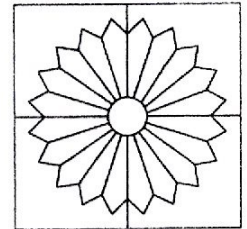




BLOCK ASSEMBLY, CONT:

4. Sew 4 appliqued squares together in pairs, then sew the pairs together. Press seams open. Use heat resistant template plastic to cut a circle. Place the template on the wrong side of the flower center fabric and cut $\frac{1}{4}$ " larger all the way around. Leaving template in center of fabric, apply spray starch to the fabric edge that extends beyond the plastic, then heat press the $\frac{1}{4}$ " edge back over the template until dry, creating a crisp edge. Machine or hand applique the circle to the center of the appliqued squares to complete one $26\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " block. Repeat to make 4 blocks.

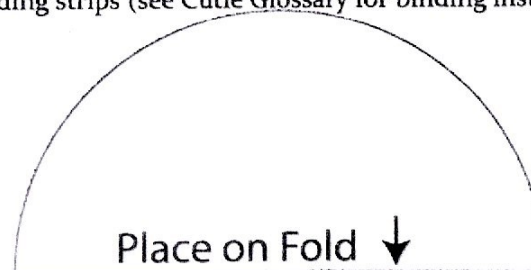
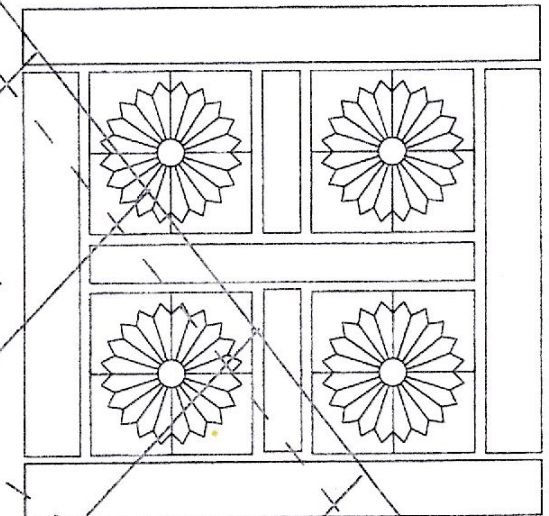


QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Quilt Center. Trim (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips to measure $26\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Sew one of the trimmed off pieces short ends together with the remaining $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF piece to make one long strip. Trim this strip to measure $55\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew a shorter strip between 2 blocks. Press seams toward the sashing to make one row. Make a second row. Sew the longer strip between the rows to complete the $55\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt center.

Borders. Sew the (7) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF border strips short ends (or diagonally) together to make one long strip. Cut (2) $55\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths and (2) $67\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths. Sew the shorter strips to opposite sides of the quilt center and the longer strips to the other sides.

Finishing. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF binding strips (see Cutie Glossary for binding instructions.)



CUTIE

MATERIALS:

Cutie Pack	1
Background	2½ yards
Sashing	¾ yard
Border & Binding	1⅞ yards
Batting	75" x 75" piece
Backing	75" x 75" piece
Template plastic	
Optional Creative Grid Dresden Plate ruler	

CUTTING:

Note: Trace the wedge and circle patterns onto template plastic and cut out neatly.

From 15 cuties (reserve the darkest shade cutie piece for flower center):

Cut a total of 80 petals using the wedge template

From the darkest shade cutie piece:

Cut 4 circles using the circle template, follow directions under block assembly

From the background fabric:

Cut (16) 13½" squares

From the sashing fabric:

Cut (3) 3½" x WOF strips

From the border & binding fabric:

Cut (7) 6½" x WOF strips for borders

Cut (7) 2½" x WOF strips for binding

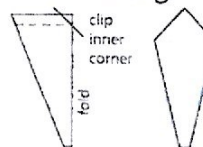

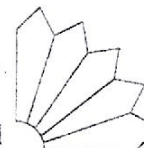
BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Note: Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even. Use a ¼" seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.

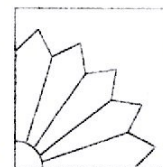
1. Fold one cutie petal in half lengthwise with right sides together. Sew across the top of the petal, backstitching at the end to secure. Clip the inner corner and turn right side out. Press the seam centered at the back of the petal open. Repeat to make 80 petals.



2. Place 2 petals right sides together aligning raw edges and stitch down one long side, backstitching at the top. Press seam open. Attach 3 more petals in the same manner. Make a total of (16) 5 petal units.



3. Center each 5 petal unit on one corner of a 13½" background square, aligning the long side of each end petal with the sides of the square. Pin in place. Machine or hand applique the pointed ends of the petals only onto the background square. Remove the background fabric from behind the petals and square up to measure 13½" x 13½". Make 16 appliqued squares.



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
