



## QUILT CENTER, CONT:

**2. Side sections.** Sew 2 different large FG units (from 2 different like piles) together as shown, then sew a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " background piece to the bottom to make an  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " side unit. Make 4 identical units. Reserve the other 2 like piles for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> borders.



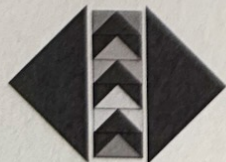
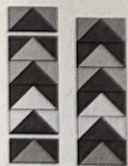
**3. Small Flying Geese (FG) units.** Follow the same procedure as in step 1 to make (12)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " small FG units using (12)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " cutie pieces and (24)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares. In the same manner, make 12 small reverse FG units using  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background pieces and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cutie squares.



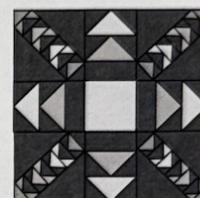
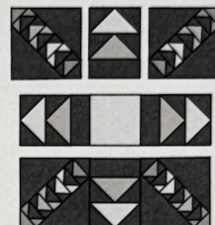
FG unit      Reverse FG unit

**4. Corner sections.** Set aside 4 different  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " cutie triangles and 4 (matching cutie fabric) small reverse FG units (these will be the upper right corner of the 4 corner sections). Noting orientation and placement, and using small FG units, sew 2 units and 2 matching reverse units together as shown. Sew a small FG unit to the bottom, and a reverse unit (that was set aside previously) to the top to make a chevron strip. Press all seams in one direction.

Center and sew a  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " background triangle to each side of the chevron strip. Press seams toward the triangle. Sew a  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " background triangle to the bottom left corner and the matching  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " cutie triangle (previously set aside) to the upper right corner. Trim the unit evenly to measure  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4 corner sections.



**5. Center square.** Noting orientation, sew 4 side sections, 4 corner sections, and the  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " cutie square together into 3 rows. Press row seams in opposing directions, then sew the rows together to complete the  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " center square.



## BORDERS

**First border.** Sew a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " accent strip to each side of 2 identical, large FG units (set aside from step 2) to make (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew to opposite sides of the center square. Make 2 more strips using  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " accent strips and the other 2 large FG units. Sew to the other side of the center square. The quilt top measures  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

**Second border.** Sew a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " accent strip to each side of 2 identical, large FG units to make (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew to opposite sides of the center square. Make 2 more strips using  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " accent strips and the remaining large FG units. Sew to the other side of the center square. The quilt top measures  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

**Third border.** Sew (12)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " cutie pieces alternately together with (11)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " accent pieces to make a  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " pieced strip. Make 4 strips. Sew a strip to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew a  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " accent square to each end of the other 2 pieced strips, then sew to the other sides of the quilt top. The quilt top measures  $58\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

**Fourth border.** Sew the (7)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF border strips together to make one long strip. Cut (2)  $58\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths and (2)  $64\frac{1}{2}$ " lengths. Sew the shorter strips to opposite sides of the quilt top and the longer strips to the other sides.

**Finishing.** Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (7)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF binding strips (see the *Cutie Glossary* for binding instructions).

## MATERIALS:

| Accent + 1 <sup>st</sup> & 3 <sup>rd</sup> borders | 1 3/8 yards     |
| Background                                         | 2 1/2 yards     |
| Binding                                            | 5/8 yard        |
| Batting                                            | 72" x 72" piece |
| Backing                                            | 72" x 72" piece |

## CUTTING:

**Note:** Width of fabric (WOF) is fabric cut from selvage to selvage.

*From 1 cutie, cut:*

- (1) 8 1/2" square (center square)
- (2) 2 1/2" squares (for small Flying Geese units)
- (1) 3 3/4" square cut diagonally in half (for corner section)
- (2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces (for 3<sup>rd</sup> border)

*From each of 4 cuties, cut:*

- (4) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces (for large Flying Geese units)

*From the remaining 11 cuties, cut a total of:*

- (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces (for small Flying Geese units)
- (22) 2 1/2" squares (for small Flying Geese units)

*From each of 3 of these cuties, cut (1) 3 3/4" square, then cut diagonally in half (for corner sections)*

*From all remaining cutie fabrics, cut a total of:*

- (46) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces

*From the accent, 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> border, cut:*

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips;  
subcut (44) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" pieces and (4) 6 1/2" squares (for 3<sup>rd</sup> border)
- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips;  
subcut (4) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips and (4) 4 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips (for 1<sup>st</sup> border)

## CUTTING, CONT:

*From the background, cut:*

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip;  
subcut (4) 9 1/2" squares, then cut each diagonally in half
- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips;  
subcut (4) 4 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips and (4) 4 1/2" x 19 1/2" strips (for 2<sup>nd</sup> border)
- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (32) 4 1/2" squares (for large Flying Geese units) and (2) 3 3/4" squares, then cut the 3 3/4" squares diagonally in half (for corner sections)
- (8) 3 1/2" x WOF strips;  
subcut 1 strip into (4) 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces (for quilt center) reserve 7 strips for 4<sup>th</sup> border
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips;  
subcut (12) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces and (24) 2 1/2" squares (for small Flying Geese units)

*From the binding, cut:*

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF binding strips

## QUILT CENTER:

**1. Large Flying Geese (FG) units.** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 4 1/2" background squares. Place a marked square right side together on one end of a 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" cutie piece. Sew on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", then press the triangle open. Repeat on the other end noting direction of the marked line. Make a total of 16 large FG units (4 sets of 4 like cuties). Stack like units in separate piles.



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
