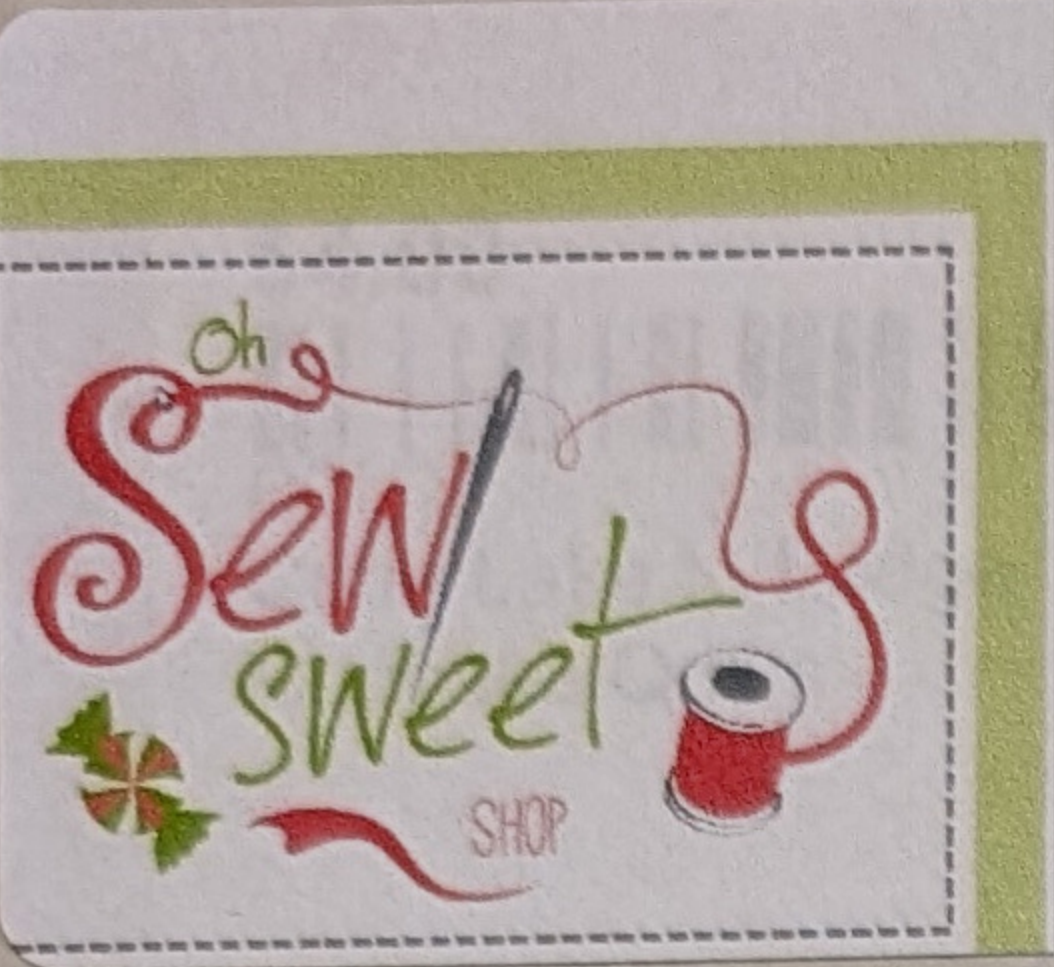




LAKE TO LODGE

PIECING CONT:

Cut (2) 48½" lengths and (2) 50½" lengths. Sew the shorter strips to opposite sides of the quilt center, then sew the longer strips to the remaining sides. Press seams toward the border.

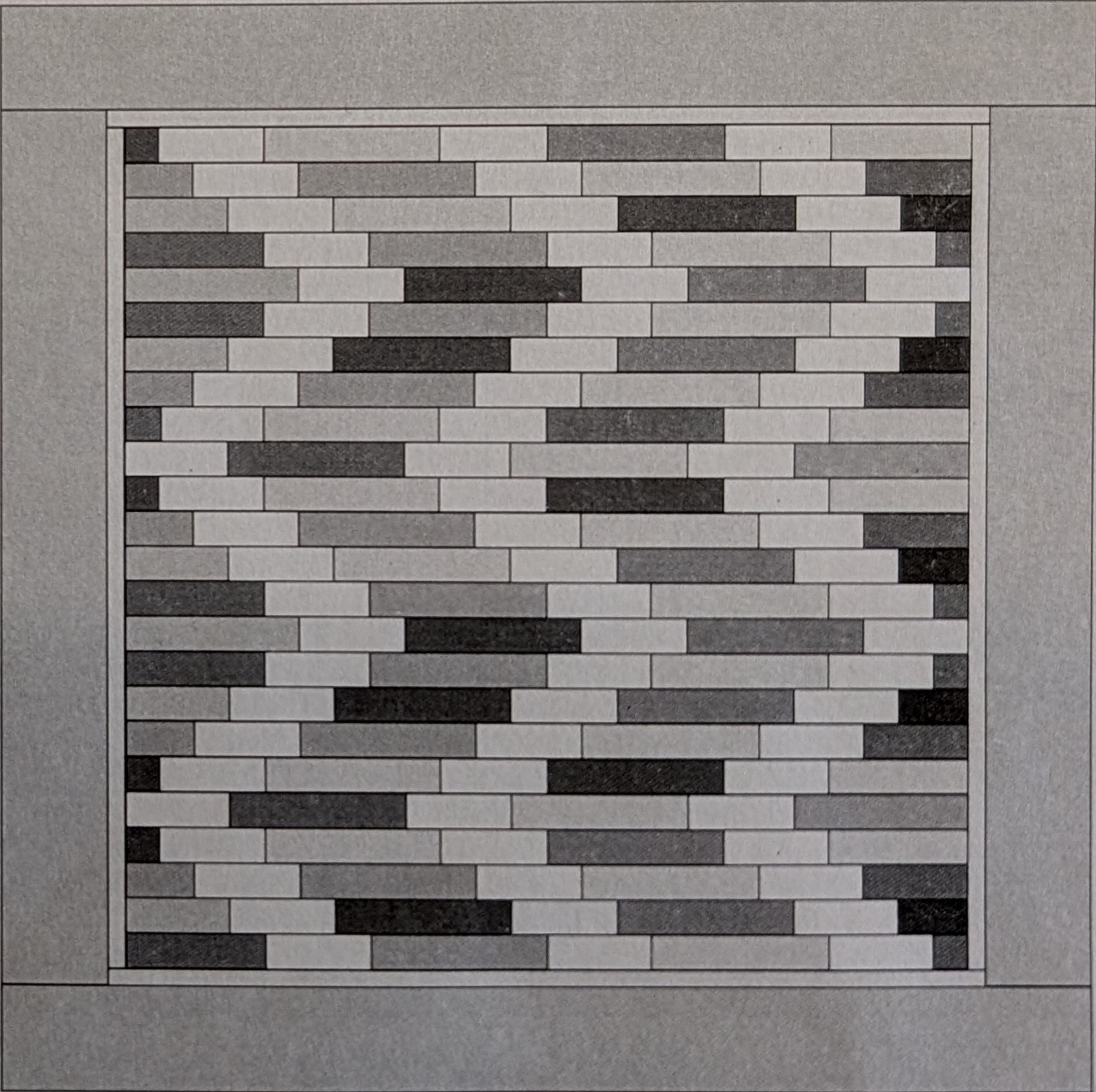
Outer border: Sew the outer border strips together to make one long strip. Cut (2) 50½" lengths and (2) 62½" lengths. Sew the shorter strips to opposite sides of the quilt top, then sew the longer strips to the remaining sides.

Finishing: Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (7) 2½" x WOF binding strips (see *Cutie Glossary* for binding instructions.)

MATERIALS:

Cutie Pack	1
Background fabric	1 yard
Inner border	$\frac{1}{3}$ yard
Outer border and binding	$1\frac{3}{4}$ yards
Backing	70" x 70" piece
Batting	70" x 70" piece

CUTTING:

From each of 13 dark cuties:

Cut (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips for a total of 39 strips.

Subcut strips into the following number of assorted color pieces. Label and stack pieces in separate piles by letter.

(52) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " (A) pieces

(10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (B) pieces

(10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (C) pieces

(10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (D) pieces

(10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (E) squares

From background fabric:

Cut (12) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips

Subcut into (72) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (F) pieces

From inner border fabric:

Cut (6) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips

From outer border & binding fabric:

Cut (6) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, for outer border

Cut (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, for binding

PIECING:

Note: Refer to the designated letters in the Row Chart to assemble rows 1 through 24. Sew pieces right sides together and raw edges even, using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

1. Sew pieces E, F, A, F, A, F, and B short ends together, as designated in Row 1, to make one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Press seams away from the F pieces.
2. In the same manner, only using the designated letter pieces as shown in the chart, make rows 2 through 24. As each row is completed, lay it out on the floor or design wall to make sure the background (F) pieces are offset evenly (there will be 3 F pieces in each row). See the Quilt Diagram.
3. Sew strips lengthwise together in pairs, then sew the pairs together to complete the $48\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt center. Press seams to one side.

Inner border: Sew the inner border strips short ends together to make one long strip.

(Measure your quilt horizontally, then vertically through the center. If your quilt center measurements differ from the measurements given, cut your border strips accordingly.)
