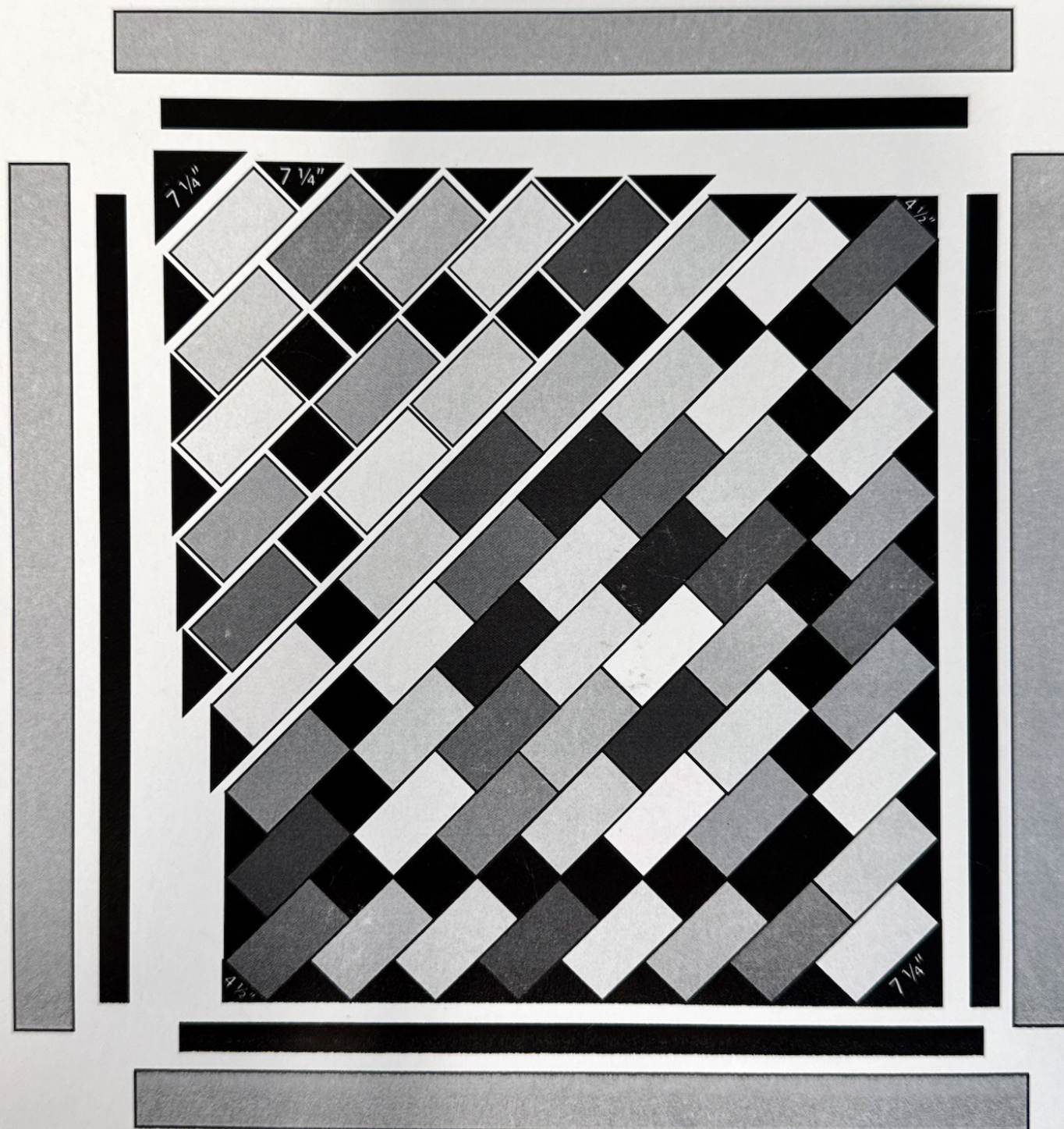

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## MATERIALS:

|                           |                       |
|---------------------------|-----------------------|
| Cutie pack                | 1                     |
| Background & inner border | 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yards |
| Outer border & binding    | 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards |
| Batting & backing fabric  | 71" x 78" each        |

## CUTTING:

**Note:** Width of fabric (WOF) is fabric cut from selvage to selvage. Length of fabric (LOF) is fabric cut parallel with the selvage.

*From each cutie, cut:*

- (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces

*From the background & inner border, cut:*

- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips (for inner border)
- (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips; subcut (25) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (for quilt center), then cut 1 square diagonally in half once (for corner triangles)
- (2) 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips; subcut (9) 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut 8 squares diagonally in half twice (for side triangles), then cut 1 square diagonally in half once (for corner triangles)

*From the outer border and binding, cut:*

- (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF strips (for outer border)
- (5) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF strips (for binding)

## ASSEMBLY:

**Note:** Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout. Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even.

1. Referring to the **Quilt Layout Diagram** for placement, sew the Cutie pieces randomly together with the 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares and 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " side triangles into 16 diagonal rows. Press row seams in opposite directions, then nesting seams, sew the rows together. Press seams in one direction first from the back then from the front. Trim evenly all the way around leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance at all Cutie/background intersections. The quilt center measures *approximately* 48 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". (Measurements are approximate due to variations in the quilting process.)

2. **Inner border.** Sew the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide inner border strips short ends together to make one long strip. Cut (2) 50" lengths and (2) 60" lengths. Sew the shorter strips to the short sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the borders and trim any excess at each end. Sew the longer strips to the other sides. Press and trim excess.

3. **Outer border.** Trim 2 outer border strips to measure 61" long. Sew a strip to each long side of quilt top. Press seams toward the border and trim excess. Sew the remaining outer border strips to the top and bottom. Press and trim excess.

4. **Finishing.** Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide binding strips (see the *Cutie Glossary* for binding instructions).

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
