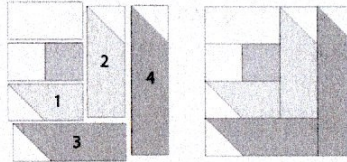

PIECING CONT:

2. Block: Sew a 2" background square to a 2" cutie square. Press. Stitch a 2" x 3½" background piece to the top of the unit. Press toward the background piece. The flower center measures 3½" x 3½". Sew the quick corner units to each adjacent side of the flower center in numerical order to complete (1) 6½" x 6½" block.



3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make a total of 24 assorted blocks.

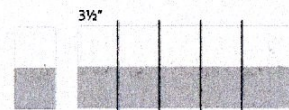
Quilt Center. Noting placement, sew 4 blocks together to make (1) 12½" center square. Sew a 6½" x 12½" background strip to each side of the center square. Press toward the background fabric. Sew a 6½" x 24½" background strip to the other sides.

First Border. Sew four blocks together to make one border section. Press seams open. Make a second border section. Stitch these sections to each of 2 opposite sides of the quilt center. Make 2 more sections containing 6 blocks each, and sew to the other sides of the quilt center.

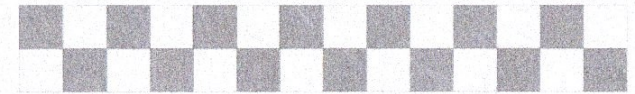
Second Border. Sew a 3½" x 36½" background strip to each of 2 opposite sides of the quilt top. Press seams toward the borders. Sew a 3½" x 42½" background strip to the other sides.

Third Border. Sew each 3½" x 16" cutie strip lengthwise to a 3½" x 16" background strip to make 16 assorted strip sets.

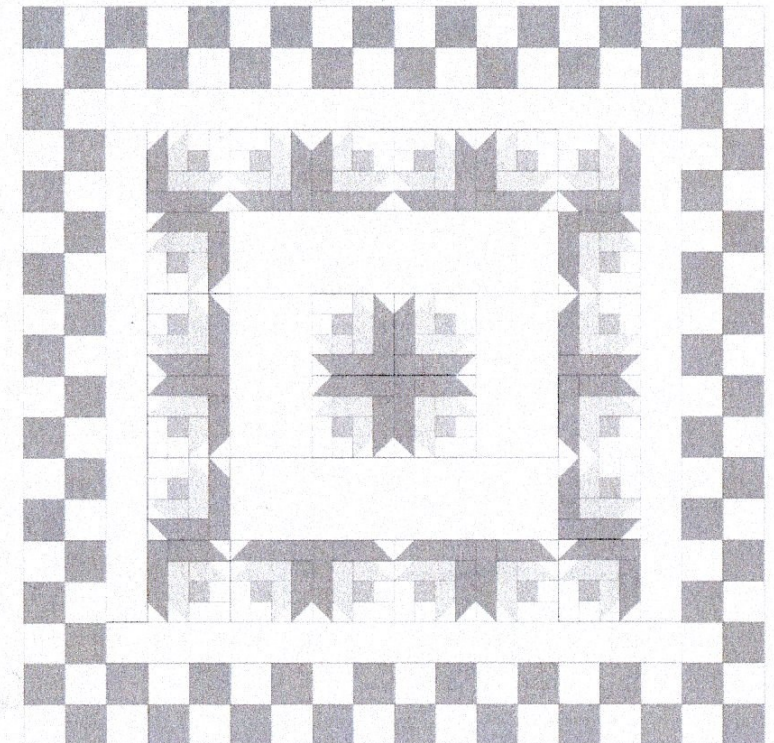
Crosscut (64) 3½" wide segments.



Sew 14 segments randomly together to make one border strip. Make a second border strip. Sew these strips to each of 2 opposite sides of the quilt top. Make 2 more border strips, each containing 18 segments, and stitch to the other sides of the quilt top.



Finishing. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Bind using the (6) 2½" x WOF binding strips (see *Cutie Glossary* for binding instructions.)





SPRING FLOWERS

MATERIALS:

Cutie Pack	1
Background	2¼ yards
Batting	62" x 62"
Backing	62" x 62"
Binding	⅝ yard

CUTTING:

From each of 8 Cuties:

Cut (1) 3½" x 22" strip
Subcut into (1) 3½" x 16" strip
(2) 2" squares

Cut (2) 2" x 22" strips
Subcut 1 strip into (2) 2" x 6½" pieces
(2) 2" x 3½" pieces
Subcut 1 strip into (4) 2" x 5" pieces

From each of 8 Cuties:

Cut (1) 3½" x 22" strip
Subcut into (1) 3½" x 16" strip
(1) 2" square

Cut (1) 2" x 22" strip
Subcut 1 strip into (1) 2" x 6½" pieces
(2) 2" x 5" pieces
(1) 2" x 3½" piece

From background:

Cut (2) 6½" x WOF strips
Subcut each strip into (1) 6½" x 24½" strip
(1) 6½" x 12½" strip

CUTTING CONT:

From background:

Cut (12) 3½" x WOF strips
Subcut 8 strips into (16) 3½" x 16" strips
Subcut 2 strips into (2) 3½" x 42½" strips
Subcut 2 strips into (2) 3½" x 36½" strips
Cut (8) 2" x WOF strips
Subcut into (120) 2" squares
(24) 2" x 3½" pieces

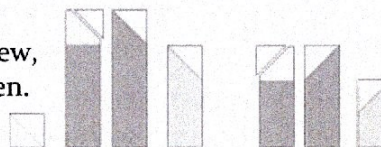
From binding:

Cut (6) 2½" x WOF strips

PIECING:

Note: Sew all pieces with right sides together and raw edges even. Use ¼" seam allowance. Press seams toward the darker fabrics unless otherwise instructed.

1. Quick Corner Units: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of (4) 2" background squares. Place a marked square right sides together on one end of a 2" x 6½" cutie piece and a different 2" x 5" cutie piece. Sew on the drawn lines, trim seam allowances to ¼", and press triangles open. In the same manner and noting orientation of the drawn line, place a background square on a 2" x 5" cutie piece (using the same print as the 2" x 6½" cutie) and a 2" x 3½" cutie piece (using the same print as the 2" x 5" cutie). Sew, trim and press triangles open.



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
